ANSWERS:

You cannot Redouble partner's double, no matter what you think of him/her!

1. When you are responding to a takeout double and your only long suit is the opponent's suit, you must make your cheapest bid in a 3 card suit.

1H therefore is the answer. You cannot pass or opponent will make 1D doubled for a big score.

The response of 1NT to a Takeout double shows 8-10 HCP and a stopper in opponent's suit.

1. 2D. You cuebid the suit your opponents have bid. This will show 10 or more points and asks your partner to pick her best major. With 10-12 points only, you promise to have 4-4 in the majors.

If you pick Hearts instead, partner will have three Hearts and four Spades. If you pick Spades, he/she will have three Spades and four Hearts. So you have to pass the buck and make her choose the major.

If partner bids 2 Hearts or 2 Spades only, you will now pass as you have already told your story.

Partner will never pass your 2D bid.

1. In order to bid in response to partner's takeout double, when you are not FORCED to do so (there has been an intervening bid), you have to have 8 or more points.

On this hand, you can happily pass.
